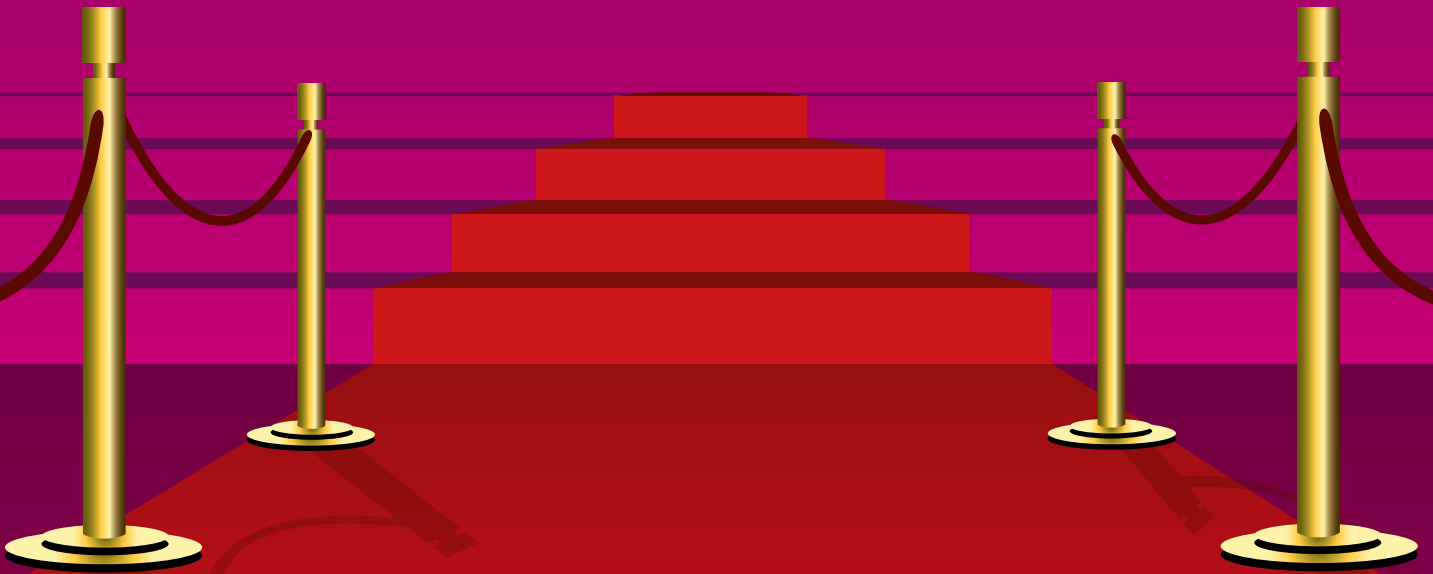

### Cannes

When thinking of Cannes, the first thing that might come to mind is the red carpet. Normally rolled out in May for international movie stars, it now gives our conference in September an appropriate framework to welcome physicians and key-opinions leaders from all five continents to the leading conference on neuromodulators, fillers, cosmeceuticals, emerging technologies and energy-based devices.
