PROMOTING SCIENCE

The Groups of Integrated Pharmacology and Neuroscience of the IMIM (Hospital del Mar Research Institute of Medical Investigations) and the Group of Cellular and Systems Neurobiology of the Center for Genomic Regulation of Barce-Iona (CRG) carry out clinical studies for the improvement of cognitive performance in people with genetic intellectual disabilities or neurodegenerative diseases, such as Alzheimer's disease.

The research groups have the best neuroscientists, and specialists in clinical pharmacology, biochemistry, genetics, neuropsychology, neurophysiology and neuroimaging. We prioritize research that allows us to improve the treatments of the people we attend and we have disco-

vered a treatment that is effective in improving the cognitive capacities in the adult with Down Syndrome and Fragile X Syndrome and was published in Lancet Neurology last

At this time, our goal is to start a pediatric clinical trial. We believe that children will benefit the most from this treatment; however, it is very difficult for the public administration to fund research on Down Syndrome. In recent years it has seen a significant reduction in economic resources, due to the prioritization of more prevalent diseases (cancer, cardiovascular, etc.). To achieve our goal, the total budget required is approximately € 700,000.
